

## Free Coaching & Allied Scheme

### Ministry

Ministry of Minority Affairs

### About

This scheme aims to empower the students belonging to minority communities and prepare them for competitive examination, so that their participation in government and private jobs improve.

### Benefits

The scheme provides financial support for free coaching to minority students in selected coaching institutions.

### Eligibility

Eligible Organizations for receiving financial assistance under this scheme:

- All Institutes in the government sector, including universities and autonomous bodies, engaged in professional coaching for competitive examination.
- Universities/Colleges in private Sector engaged in professional coaching activities, including deemed Universities.
- Trusts, Companies, Partnership Firms, or Societies registered under Societies Registration Act, 1960 and engaged in professional coaching.

Eligible Candidates/Students

- Candidates must have secured the requisite percentage of marks in the qualifying examination
- Only Candidates belonging to the notified Minority Communities
- Total family income from all sources not exceeding Rs. 3.00 lakh per annum.
- Benefits of coaching under the scheme can be availed by a particular student once only.
- Students/Candidates covered under the scheme shall have to attend all classes.
- 30% of the numbers sanctioned for coaching shall be earmarked for girl students/candidates.

### How to Apply

The Institutes in Government Sector can send proposals in the prescribed proforma, directly to the Ministry of Minority Affairs, the Organizations in the Private Sector, including Non-Governmental organizations (NGOs) should submit their proposals through the State Government/UT Administration concerned.
